Tournament Conditions

- 1. The tournament will be played under the rules of TTNZ.
- 2. Stag white 3 Star balls will be used.
- 3. All Singles Events will start with group play with the top two qualifying to the main draw and the remainder qualifying for the plate.
- 4. All matches except for post section play in the Open division will be the best of 5 advantage games up to 11
- 5. Post section play in the Open division will be best of 7 advantage games up to 11.
- 6. Consolation events will be played for singles competitions if time permits.
- 7. The Association reserves the right to cancel or combine events for which less than four entries are received.
- 8. If insufficient women's entries are received, the Association may combine Men's & Women's sections in the veteran events.
- 9. If insufficient girl's entries are received, the Association may combine Boy's & Girl's sections in the junior events.
- 10. All singles events are New Zealand Rating events.
- 11. December 31st 2010 is the date used for determining eligibility for Junior age group events.
- 12. December 31st 2011 is the date used for determining eligibility for Veteran group events.
- 13. Players may enter as many events as they wish on the Saturday as long as they are not scheduled to start at the same time.
- 14. Players may enter any two age groups on the Sunday.
- 15. Light refreshments and drinks will be available throughout the day.
- 16. Please enter "Partner Required" if you need a Doubles partner; otherwise state your partner's name.
- 17. Prizes will be presented on the day.

Grading Criteria

1. Eligibility for B, C and D grades shall be determined from the TTNZ rating list at the closing date.

B Grade	26 or below	21 or below
C Grade	101 or below	51 or below
D Grade	201 or below	101 or below

2. TTW reserves the right to re-rate entries for the graded events from players who do not appear on the NZ rating list.
