Tournament Conditions

- 1. The tournament will be played under the rules of TTNZ.
- 2. Stag 3-Star 'White' plastic balls will be used.
- 3. All Singles Events will start with group play with the top two qualifying to the main draw.
- 4. All matches except for the post section Open will be the best of 5 advantage games up to 11.
- Post section play in the Open will be best of 7 advantage games up to 11.
- 6. The Association reserves the right to cancel or combine events for which less than four entries are received.
- 7. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to decline entry into or remove a player, coach or spectator from the tournament. There is no right of appeal to a decision made by the Tournament Manager, as regards this condition.
- 8. If insufficient women's entries are received, the Association may combine Men's & Women's sections in the veteran events.
- 9. If insufficient girl's entries are received, the Association may combine Boy's & Girl's sections in the junior events.
- 10. This is a New Zealand Rating event.
- 11. December 31st 2018 is the date used for determining eligibility for Junior age group events.
- 12. December 31st 2019 is the date used for determining eligibility for Veteran group events.
- 13. Eligibility for B, C, and D grades shall be determined from the TTNZ rating list as at the closing date for entries:

Men: B grade 26 or below (>= 26), C grade 101 or below (>= 101), D grade 201 or below (>= 201).

Women: B grade 21 or below (>= 21), C grade 51 or below (>= 51), D grade 101 or below (>= 101).

- 14. TTW reserves the right to rate or re-rate entries for players who do not appear on the TTNZ rating list.
- 15. Players may enter as many eligible events as they wish on either day as long as they are not scheduled to start at the same time.
- 16. Light refreshments and drinks will be available throughout the day.
- 17. Please enter "Partner Required" if you need a Doubles partner; otherwise state your partner's name (and ensure they enter!).
- 18. Reasonable use of photos or video taken during the tournament may be made on the Table Tennis Wellington website and Facebook page for publicity purposes. Use the entry form to indicate if you don't want a photo or video of you to be used in this way.
- 19. Prizes will be presented on the day.
- 20. Consolation events may or may not be organised in any or all events depending on numbers and time available under conditions determined by the Tournament Manager.
