Tournament Conditions

- 1. The tournament will be played under the rules of TTNZ except as listed below.
- 2. Stag 3 Star white plastic balls will be used.
- 3. The Mixed Singles Open will be played in 3 or 4 player round robin groups with the top player in the group qualifying for the A grade, the second player the B grade, the third player the C grade and the fourth player the D grade. A knock out competition will then take place for all four grades.
- 4. All other Singles Events will start with group play with the top two qualifying to the main draw.
- 5. All matches <u>except</u> for the post section Open singles will be the best of 5 advantage games up to 11.
- 6. Post section play in the Open singles will be best of 7 advantage games up to 11.
- 7. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to decline entry into or remove a player, coach or spectator from the tournament. There is no right of appeal to a decision made by the Tournament Manager, as regards this condition.
- 8. Table Tennis Wellington reserves the right to cancel or combine events for which less than four entries are received.
- 9. If insufficient women's entries are received, Table Tennis Wellington may combine Men's & Women's sections in the veteran events.
- 10. If insufficient girl's entries are received, Table Tennis Wellington may combine Boy's & Girl's sections in the junior events.
- 11. All singles events are New Zealand Rating events.
- 12. 31 December 2018 is the date used for determining eligibility for Junior age group events.
- 13. 31 December 2019 is the date used for determining eligibility for Veteran group events.
- 14. Players may enter as many eligible events as they wish on the Saturday.
- 15. Players may enter as many eligible events as they wish on the Sunday as long as they are not scheduled to start at the same time.
- 16. Light refreshments and drinks will be available throughout both days.
- 17. Please enter "Partner Required" if you need a Doubles partner; otherwise state your partner's name.
- 18. Reasonable use of photos or video taken during the tournament may be used on the Table Tennis Wellington website or Facebook page for publicity and communication. Please use the entry form to indicate if you do not want identifiable photos or video of you to be used.
- 19. Prizes will be presented on the day.
