Regulations:

- 1. The tournament will be played under the rules of TTNZ except as listed below.
- 2. Stag 3 Star white plastic balls will be used. Stag tables will be used.
- 3. The Men's Open Singles will be played in 3 or 4 player round robin groups with the top two players in each group qualifying for the Open post section. A knockout competition will then take place.
- 4. For the Women's Open Singles, any post section format required after a round robin stage will be determined by the number of entries received and advised to players before the commencement of the event.
- 5. All other Singles Events will start with group play with the top two in each group qualifying to the main draw.
- 6. All matches except for the post section Open singles will be the best of 5 advantage games up to 11.

- 7. Post section play in the Open singles will be best of 7 advantage games up to 11.
- 8. Consolation events will not be held for any events.
- 9. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to decline entry into or remove a player, coach, or spectator from the tournament. There is no right of appeal to a decision made by the Tournament Manager, as regards this condition.
- 9. Table Tennis Wellington reserves the right to cancel or combine events for which less than four entries are received.
- 10. If insufficient women's entries are received, Table Tennis Wellington may combine Men's & Women's sections in the veteran events.
- 11. If insufficient girl's entries are received, Table Tennis Wellington may combine Boy's & Girl's sections in the junior events.
- 12. All singles events are New Zealand Rating events.
- 13. 31 December 2021 is the date used for determining eligibility for Junior group events.
- 14. **31 December 2022** is the date used for determining eligibility for **Veteran** group events.
- 15. Rating Eligibility
- B Grade Men 26 or below from the TTNZ Rating list as at: 22/07/2022
- Women 21 or below from the TTNZ Rating list as at: 22/07/2022
- C Grade Men 101 or below from the TTNZ Rating list as at: 22/07/2022
- Women 51 or below from the TTNZ Rating list as at: 22/07/2022
- D Grade Men 201 or below from the TTNZ Rating list as at: 22/07/2022
- Women 101 or below from the TTNZ Rating list as at: 22/07/2022

TTW reserves the right to rate or re-rate entries for players who do not appear on the TTNZ ratings lists.

- 16. Players may enter only one event for which they are eligible on the Saturday morning and cannot enter both Open and C Grade events on that afternoon. On Sunday players may enter only enter one event in the morning and one event in the afternoon for which they are eligible.
- 17. Players cannot enter two doubles events scheduled for the same time slot but may enter different singles and doubles age groups happening at the same time.
- 18. Please enter "Partner Required" if you need a Doubles partner; otherwise enter your partner's name.
- 19. Reasonable use of photos or video taken during the tournament may be used on the Table Tennis Wellington website or Facebook page for publicity and communication. Please advise the Tournament Manager if you do not want identifiable photos or video of you to be used.
