Each Division will play a full round robin over 3.5 weeks, with a final as the last round of week 4. The final round will match the top two teams, with the remainder playing off 3v4, 5v6 and 7v8.

Doubles will only be played if the score after the four singles is a 2-2 tie. A sudden death, one set doubles match (changes ends and order at 5) will determine the winner.

Points will be awarded at one point per each contest won. If teams are equal on points, singles matches won will determine placings. If further assessment is required to break ties, the final result between the affected teams within the round robin phase will be used.

The Summer Interclub timetable allows for five weeks. On the fifth and final week there will be a singles tournament for players who played in the earlier rounds. More details later.
